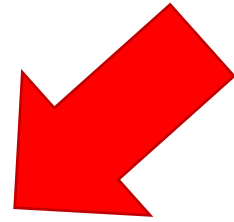

CME REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

The American College of Surgeons, our joint provider for CME credits, has instituted new rules as they pertain to claiming CME credits. We are required to report the data by the set deadline of the American College of Surgeons, in accordance with ACCME standards. Late submissions, unfortunately, cannot be accepted.

HARD DEADLINE: MARCH 19, 2025

HOW TO CLAIM CME CREDIT
